Total cost to Government to provide Shipping Containers at sportsgrounds including electricity, groundwork etc?

Ms Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

There is no direct cost to Government. Sporting clubs provide their own shipping containers for storage of equipment at their own cost. Containers are for storage only and do not have service connections. The government's role is to facilitate and approve the placement of containers on public land as part of its broader public land management responsibilities.
