Inquiry into ACT Budget 2021–22 ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Asked by Mr Mark Parton MLA:

Ref: Transport Canberra, Budget Statement H, page 45, Output classes 1 and 2

In relation to Budget Statement H, page 45, table 2 provides the aggregate payments for community service obligations (CSO).

- 1. What is the split of each CSO figure (2020-21 Budget to 2024-25 Estimate) in table 22 in terms of:
 - a. Public transport services;
 - b. City services; and
 - c. Other services?
- 2. How is the CSO payment amount determined for each service for each year?
- 3. Are CSO payments contained in the Controlled Recurrent Payments figures at BS-H page 54, table 27, and if so:
 - a. What is the amount of the CSO payment contained in each of those figures?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

1. The CSO amounts reflected in the TCCS Cash Flow Statement on page 45 of Budget Statement H, Table 22 are split as follows:

- 2. The CSO payment for Yarralumla Nursery is a historical annual amount of \$321,000. The CSO payment for Public Transport Services is a combination of base funding, any new or ceasing initiatives related to the Transport Canberra Operations and any indexation adjustments.
- 3. Yes, the CSO payments are included in the total Controlled Recurrent Payments figure of \$207.094 million at Budget Statement H, page 54, table 27 which reports total Output Class 1, Transport Canberra Operating Statement.
