In relation to: Supporting smarter working in the new ACT Government office projects

1. What will be accomplished by the four years of funding for the initiative 'Supporting smarter working in the new ACT Government office projects'?

RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The 'Supporting smarter working in the new ACT Government office projects' budget initiative was funded in the 2019-20 Budget.

In 2019-20 and 2020-21, CSD was allocated \$426,000 and \$439,000 to support the transition of the Directorate to the new office building with activity based work, including to provide additional funding for portable ICT infrastructure and digital record-keeping.

The transfer of funding received by CSD in the 2021-22 Budget is part of the 2019-20 initiative allocation to CMTEDD to support the continuing transition.
