1. Why was the \$5,000 intended for 2020-21 not spent and why was this spending pushed back to 2021-2022?

- 3. Can the Minister provide an itemised list of what this line item will be used for and at what cost for each item?
- 4. What exactly are the deliverables from this line item?
- 5. Will we have a complete design and plan for the construction of the AMC reintegration centre by June 2022?

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

In the context of further work on the proposed Reintegration Centre having been paused, in response to changing circumstances and accommodation priorities at the Alexander Maconochie Centre (AMC):

The \$5,000 was reprofiled to 2021-22. This line item relates to the Transitional Release Centre (TRC) expansion which was funded in the 2018-19 budget review process – in particular the finalisation of design works. The timing of finalisation of design works is linked to the pause on the work on the proposed Reintegration Centre.
