I would love to circle back to WHS, which you mentioned there is a protection framework there. Have there been any WHS inspections or concerns about that site
Mick Gentleman: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—
A WorkSafe ACT inspector attended the Giralang shops site on 23 January 2017 in response to a complaint from a member of the public. Upon inspection it was established that WorkSafe ACT had no jurisdiction as there were nil workers on site and no work being conducted, it was evident the site was not active and therefore not a workplace for the purposes of the Work Health and Safety Act 2011.
No further inspections have been undertaken.
