Hi Mark,

Honourable Parton has asked me to contact you about the speeding ticket I received at Cnr Barry Drive and Marcus Clarke Street on 27th July, 2021. I contacted him about this as a friend told me he was raising questions about it.

I had gone to pick up my granddaughter from St Clare's as she was sick. I live at Bruce. I was travelling at 47kms hour in the 40km zone. I received a \$301 fine.

Parkes Way was closed off and I missed the Detour which would have taken me back onto Parkes Way. It was pouring with rain. I would not have normally gone through the city. I was totally unaware that there was a new speed camera in this place. There is inadequate signage to indicate this.

I have since found three other people who have been caught out by this speed camera. One person had received \$1,600 in fines and the other \$900.

I am applying to have the fine waived. I have obtained a copy of my NSW Driving record as I have only lived in ACT 3 years. NSW has adequate signage to inform drivers they are approaching Speed Cameras.
