I am wondering if you can also provide us the breakdown of the levels of the different, you know, the public service levels of the people being investigated for misconduct?

Ms Leigh: Ms Castley, we will take on notice what we can provide, because we will need, as Mr Wright mentioned earlier, we will need to be careful about whether that leads to identification of individuals. We will take on notice, with the best intention to deliver what you requested.

1. In relation to the CMTEDD Annual Report 2020-2021 incidents of fraud (P138).

- one Senior Officer Grade B.

- two Administrative Services Officer Class 5; and
- two Administrative Services Officer Class 3.
