Asked by PETER CAIN MLA:

Ref: Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate

In relation to: Employees' working arrangements

1. Which Directorates have not been tracking employees' working arrangements?
2. Since November 2021, how many ACTPS employees have not worked a single day from home?

YVETTE BERRY MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. All directorates are required to manage their employee working arrangements in accordance with the relevant Enterprise Agreement applicable to their employees.
2. The working arrangements of the ACTPS are diverse. The service delivery nature in many areas, such as health, education, corrections, emergency services, means they are not able to work from home or remotely. Directorates manage working from home arrangements in accordance with the Enterprise Agreements that apply to their employees. As working from home arrangements are approved at the manager level and may include regular or adhoc arrangements, that data is not collected, or required to be collected, centrally.
