Thank you for your interest in enrolments and schools planning in relation to the Standing Committee on Education and Community Inclusion Inquiry into the Management of ACT School Infrastructure.

The Education Directorate received a direct request for information on 12 October 2021 and I am happy to respond as the responsible Minister.

Enrolment Forecasting

Enrolment projections are an important input into policy considerations and identify where enrolment pressure may be expected in the future. Projections inform timely decision making for demand responses which could include enrolment policy shifts as well as infrastructure responses such as expanded or new school infrastructure.

In recent years the Education Directorate has used a cohort transition model to forecast enrolments to predict future student numbers at specific schools. The cohort transition model moves groups of students forward each year from one grade to the next and predicts how students are likely to graduate from primary to high school, and then from high school to college. This model is based on the current number of students enrolled at ACT public schools by school and grade, with key inputs drawn from the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate population projection and ABS population data, as well as the biannual Education Census.

The Directorate is working closely with the Australian National University on demographic analysis and enrolment forecasting. This also includes a focus on small area modelling that captures and

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predicts all student movements from preschool to Year 12 across all public and non-government schools in the ACT. This model is known as the School Transition Estimation and Projection (STEP) model. The STEP model takes births and enrolments across all sectors from preschool and kindergarten, monitors migration across school sectors and tracks cohort progression through to end of schooling at Year 12.

The Directorate's enrolment projections also include area-specific custom modelling scenarios which take into account enrolment policy, changes in capacity at schools within regions, and changes in trends as well as different development and demographic assumptions where appropriate. The projection model has a high level of accuracy over time because it is based on reliable Education Census data. The model is most robust when considering 12-month projections and moderately robust out to five-year projections. Beyond five-year projections there is likelihood of external factors impacting the currency of data, which is an inherent and unavoidable factor in demographic projections and modelling.

The enrolment forecasting model extrapolates existing trends into the future. Over the medium to long term, enrolment trends have the potential to change due to factors noted above as well as due to enrolment policy shifts which may include changes to Priority Enrolment Areas, as well as designating high demand schools as Category A schools which are unable to accept out of area enrolments.

The revised ACT Official Population Forecast is expected to become available towards the end of 2021 at which time the Directorate will recalibrate enrolment projections based on that revised data. Given the revised population forecast is not yet available, an enrolment projection produced in 2020 for all ACT public schools for 2020-2030 is provided at [Attachment A](#).

It should be noted that year to year fluctuations may occur due to external impacts such as changes in affiliation between government and non-government schools, greenfield and infill developments as well as land release, including the timing for dwellings to come online and residents to move into these areas.

While enrolment projections are a key input into schools planning, they should not be regarded as the single point of reference for responding to demand due to changing impacts.

Priority Enrolment Areas

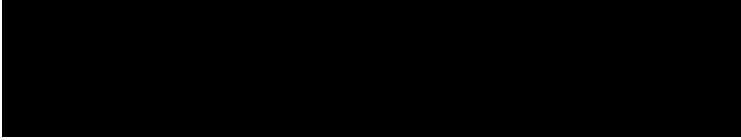
Every child from Kindergarten to Year 12 is guaranteed a place at their local public school (by Priority Enrolment Area (PEA)).

PEAs are reviewed annually, with changes made to accommodate new schools or changes in enrolment demand. Where possible, changes are notified in advance of the opening of the prospective year enrolment cycle to provide a level of certainty for families about enrolment options and to support smooth transitions between levels of schooling.
