### ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by Jonathan Davis MLA on 23 August 2022: Rebecca Kelley took on notice the following question(s):

**MR DAVIS:** I have a quick clarifying question on the Orima report. How many recommendations were there and has the government agreed to all of the recommendations?

**Ms Kelley:** I will take that on notice. With the type of recommendations in the report, it was more a research report that was for the benefit of sports. It was not necessarily something that we intended putting a government response to, in terms of accepting those recommendations. We are certainly seeing it as research, data and tool-based activity to assist not only sports but also future government decision-making around how we can best target the resources that we have.

**Ms. Yvette Berry MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The ORIMA Research Report did not include recommendations as such but rather the findings generated numerous 'opportunities for change'. These opportunities relate to the system and programs across the whole of sports sector, as well as ways to improve experience of sport and physical activity for lower income households.

A Government response to the research is not intended but the findings and noted opportunities for change will be considered in current planning and future funding provision. The key opportunities rest for delivery within the sport sector itself and the research findings were presented to peak body representatives in December 2021 to help inform their strategic thinking and activity delivery.
