Asked by Peter Cain MLA on 8 November 2022: Graham Tanton took on notice the following question(s):

Reference: Hansard uncorrected proof transcript 8 November 2022, Page 126

In relation to:

MR CAIN: Yes, I do. Staff on call allowances and overtime under property services. Are venues ACT and ACT Property Services staff paid allowances or overtime to be on call?

Mr Tanton: Yes, there are.

MR CAIN: How many staff received on call allowances or overtime in excess of \$10,000 in 21-22?

Mr Tanton: I would have to take that on notice.

MR CAIN: Thank you. What was the highest amount of on call allowances and overtime received in 21-22 by a single employee?

Mr Tanton: I will need to take that on notice as well.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

ACTPG: There were 17 staff who received more than \$10,000, either for on call allowances or overtime, for the financial year of 2021-22. The highest on call allowance and overtime that was received in the financial year 2021-22 by a single employee was \$22,691.50.

Venues ACT: There were 19 staff who received more than \$10,000, either for on call allowances or overtime, for the financial year of 2021-22. The highest on call allowance and overtime that was received in the financial year 2021-22 by a single employee was \$43,624.86.
