In relation to: Access Canberra - Speeding Fines ACT Government

- 1. For the financial years 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 (year to date), how many speeding fines have been issued to the following entities, and what was the total revenue for each:
 - a. Vehicles owned or leased by the ACT government
 - b. Vehicles owned or leased by ACT Government Ministers
- 2. How many vehicles owned or leased by the ACT government have received multiple fines since 1 July 2019?
- 3. Have any speeding have been issued to vehicles owned or leased by the ACT government and then been waived since 1 July 2020?
- 4. Have any parking fines have been issued to vehicles owned or leased by the ACT government and then waived since 1 July 2019?

Minister Cheyne: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

Questions 1(a), 1(b) and 2: Access Canberra has advised that the information sought is not in an easily retrievable form. The effort to collect and assemble the information sought solely for the purpose of answering the question would require a considerable diversion of resources.

Ouestion 3 & 4:

In situations where an ACT Government vehicle incurs a parking or traffic infringement, the infringement is transferred into the name of the driver who will then manage the matter as an individual.
