MR JAMES MILLIGAN MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Portfolio area, Budget Outlook pg 189. Output Class 2.1 Roads and Infrastructure

In relation to: Yerrabi District Park Upgrade

1. Page 189 of the budget outlook announces upgrades to the Yerrabi District Park, the Government announced 3.2m to be spent on the project, yet only 1m is being spent this financial year, can you confirm:
 - a. What is this money to be spent on?

CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

As a complex project involving several adjacent upgrades funding for this project has been allocated over two financial years – 2023-24 and 2024-25.

Funding in 2023-24 will be used to procure construction services for the main works at Yerrabi District Park and Bizant Street playground. It is expected these works will commence on site in the 2023-24 financial year and construction works will be completed in the 2024-25 financial year.

The upgrades to Yerrabi Pond will deliver:

- Design and construction of path lighting for the pond loop path.
- Upgrade to the existing picnic and toilet pavilion at the District Park. The design includes a reconfiguration of the pavilion with new accessible toilet facilities on the western side of the breeze way and the picnic facilities on the eastern side opening out to the existing picnic area. The works will include landscaping and lighting in proximity of the area.
- Construction of new toilet facilities at the Bizant Street playground and improved car parking with an accessible carparking area.
- On Phyllis Ashton Circuit and Strayleaf Crescent - installation of signage and new line marking at the existing car parking area, and construction of additional car parking adjacent to the commercial precinct.
- Phyllis Ashton Circuit and Strayleaf Crescent – construction of new picnic facilities, improvements of existing picnic facilities, and relaying of existing pavement.
