(1) What domestic and family violence training and resources are being funded under this initiative?

- (a) Who delivers the training?
- (b) Who develops the resources?
- (c) Who receives the training and resources under this initiative?
- (d) How much is funded from the safety families levy?

MINISTER BERRY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

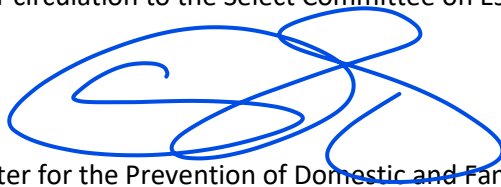
(1) To date this initiative has funded training in:

- Safe and Together model core training
 - Domestic and family violence training
 - Men's behaviour change and working with perpetrators training; and
 - Cultural competency training.
- a. Funding for training is provided directly to community organisations, who were invited to select their own training providers. The ACT Government has previously recommended the following training providers to organisations:
