Asked by Ms Lee MLA on Tuesday, 14 November 2023: Shane Rattenbury took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: In relation to the Davis allegations and subsequent report made by the Chief of Staff to ACT Policing, can the Attorney please table the mentioned incident report card, including number and ACT Policing contact.

MS LEE: Thank you, Chair. Attorney-General, yesterday in the hearing you confirmed that your Chief of Staff reported the matter to police on Friday.

Mr Rattenbury: Yes.

MS LEE: I cannot remember what the date was, was it the tenth?

Mr Rattenbury: Yes, it is Friday, 10 November.

MS LEE: Yes, Friday 10 November at around 10am I think you said.

Mr Rattenbury: Yes, I did.

MS LEE: Now, can you please confirm for me how that report was made and what information was provided to police?

Mr Rattenbury: I am just checking my notes, Ms Lee. The report was made by the Chief of Staff attending the police station and providing all of the material that he had.

MS LEE: Did you get a police report or a confirmation of the reporting?

Mr Rattenbury: I know that the Chief of Staff has an incident reporting card if you like. There is a little card with an incident number on it and a contact officer.

MS LEE: Is that something that you can table for the committee?

Mr Rattenbury: I would like to seek advice. This is a genuine question about the public disclosure of that information. I do not know what the rules are about the public—and that is a genuine question, Ms Lee, I actually do not know. I am happy to take that on notice.

MS LEE: Yes. Thank you, Attorney-General.

THE CHAIR: Thank you.

Mr Rattenbury: And whether it might, if necessary, we consider whether that goes to the committee in confidence, in private or—I just genuinely do to know.


MS LEE: I understand. Thank you.
