## Asked by Mr Peter Cain MLA

Reference: Hearing on 20 November 2023, Annual Report of Transport Canberra and City Services

In relation to: Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate and procurement

 How many times did the Director-General of the Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate make a final 'delegate' procurement decision, in the financial years 2018-19 to 2022-23?

Minister Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

1. Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) does not hold information on the delegate for all procurements in a centralised system for the period nominated in the question. To determine the number of times the Director-General was the delegate for a procurement would require review of each evaluation report for each procurement. TCCS undertakes a substantial number of large procurements each year and the Director-General is the delegate for the largest of these. The requested information is not readily available, and the work required to produce the information would be an unreasonable diversion of directorate resources.
