Mr Rampton: There are a number of rejected claims. There are also a number that are referred through to our insurance authority, so ACTIA. Again, I do not have the specific number that are rejected at this time, so I will take that number on notice.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The number of pothole claims that were denied in the 2022 calendar year was 72 and the number of pothole claims denied YTD for the 2023 calendar year is 31.
