In relation to: Payments to Calvary

**Mr Barr:** Calvary have received some funding that was obviously part of the just terms and the transition arrangement.

**MS LEE:** Yes, and how much was that?

**Mr Barr:** That amount is?

**Mr Hocking:** Stuart Hocking, Under Treasurer, CMTEDD. There are amounts that we have paid them which I roughly know, but I am a little bit unsure about whether I am allowed to reveal them. I might need to take that on notice—

**Mr Barr:** We will take that on notice.

**Mr Hocking:** —and just check with the government solicitor about that.

**Andrew Barr MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Acting on requests from Calvary and in accordance with section 24 of the Health Infrastructure Enabling Regulation 2023, the Territory has made early compensation payments to Calvary totalling \$23.2 million. Section 24 makes clear that those payments do not constitute an offer for or acceptance of any claims by Calvary for just terms compensation.
