- (1) Was CHS and CMTEDD advised to hold off tendering for new systems because Frontier Software's CHRIS21 system was the preferred model.
 - (a) If so, who gave this advice.
 - (b) Was it the Director of DDTS.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. Through the 2023-24 ACT Budget, the Government made the decision to end the HRIMS Program and continue with Chris21 and HR21 as the core HR and Payroll systems for all ACT Government directorates. The new PC-HRM program scope includes the design and implementation of a whole-of-government time and attendance capability which includes CHS and CMTEDD.
