**MR MILLIGAN:** Is the government aware of any of the High Court's decisions and visas that were granted that reside in the ACT and that are reporting to stations on bail?

**Mr Gentleman:** That is not a matter that is reported directly to ACT government.

**Mr Lee:** I can answer that, Mr Milligan. Certainly, at the moment, in terms of the overall national caseload, my understanding is there are two of those persons who are residing in the ACT. We are obviously working with our broader AFP colleagues as part of the AFP ourselves in relation to that overall operation, but those two individuals have not come to the attention of police here in the ACT, as far as I am aware, but I am happy to take that on notice, just to confirm that for you.

Mr Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

As of 2 August 2024, the ACT has one (1) person of the NZYQ cohort temporarily residing within the ACT with visa conditions in place. The person has a reporting condition imposed pursuant to the section 76B of the *Migration Act 1958* (Cth) as a condition of their visa to report at a time and place specified, orally or in writing, by the Minister from time to time.
