Vasiliki Bogiatzis took on notice the following question(s):

MS MORRIS: Not the whole of it? Okay. What is the annual office budget?

Ms Windeyer: I would need to take that on notice, but at my last check it was approximately \$20 million. That includes all of the funding that comes through us and then gets passed on to providers. Because we manage a number of core contracts with providers our budget is quite large. Not the full 20 million is for staffing.

MS MORRIS: Okay.

Minister Paterson MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The annual budget for the Domestic, Family and Sexual Violence Office is disclosed as Output Class 1.5 Safer Families in the Community Services Directorate 2024-25 Annual Budget Statements and the Supplementary Budget Papers.
