The cycle network between Woden and the City is not direct and in places it is on Adelaide Avenue where vehicles are travelling at 80km/h. Many people do not ride because they feel unsafe. Would you please provide an update on planning for a dedicated cycle path between Woden and the City.

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

I apologise to the committee and Ms Carrick for the delay in providing this response. The ACT Active Travel Plan describes the Government's ambition to develop strategic transport corridors that cater for multimodal travel. To implement the ambition of the Active Travel Plan, Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) is currently assessing the feasibility of providing a direct off-road cycleway link along Adelaide Avenue that is safe for the road environment.

Feasibility investigations for the cycleway are progressing as a separate project allied with Light Rail Stage 2B. iCBR has commenced cross-directorate and stakeholder consultation on the cycleway to ensure integration with the Southern Gateway Planning and Design Framework, the ACT Transport Strategy and Active Travel Plan.

Further stakeholder consultation on the potential City to Woden cycle route upgrades will take place later this year to inform next steps for investigations.
