In the in-camera hearing on 13 March 2025, I discussed one of the data breaches with your official Mr White, being the 'endless money loop' that allowed people to get money that was not on their balance.

Mr White corrected this description and said it should be described as an SQL injection and said at the time of the responsible disclosure from Mr Reid on 2 December, 'that vulnerability was identified very early, and it was actually identified in our community testing'.

I asked Mr White on what date the endless money loop / SQL injection was identified.

Mr White said it was identified on 14 November 2025 and on 16 November it was remediated out of the system.
