Mr Braddock, Andrew: To ask the Minister for Transport —

QON 13 states interoperability with QBY and NSW was not considered but the ACT Government 'Risk Management Plan' discusses interoperability with NSW public transport as a project objective and says 'a MyWay user in Canberra could use his or her MyWay card to access the public transport system in Sydney.' Which is correct?

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Please refer to the response to QTON 10 from the 1 May 2025 hearing which clarifies that the **Delivery Risk Register** extract (as at 11.09.2024) is not the same as the undated **Procurement Risk Management Plan**, the latter being where the referred to entry is made.

Interoperability with NSW ticketing and transit systems was a consideration in the procurement phase but was deemed not a requirement for the delivery phase as explained in the response to QON 13 from the 27 March 2025 hearing.
