DR MARISA PATERSON MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

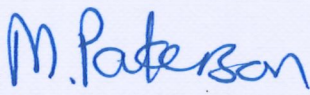
1. It is not possible to determine the amount of Betting Operations Tax revenue generated from events at Thoroughbred Park. The ACT Revenue Office does not collect data on Betting Operations Tax revenue by the location of the sporting event or the type of sport in which bets are placed.

No other gambling taxes arise from activities at Thoroughbred Park.

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2. The government has not made a decision about a future agreement following the 30 June 2027 expiry of the current MOU.
