3. The Directorate remains committed to the work of the Active Travel Office, embedded within the Strategic Policy and Programs branch (SPP). In addition to the Active Travel Office roles in SPP, there is a dedicated active travel resource that sits within the Infrastructure Planning team as part of the ongoing effort to embed active travel as a regular part of how we do business. There are several other active travel related functions delivered across the City and Environment Directorate, including the Development and Coordination Branch, responsible for school related active travel programs. This evolution reflects that active travel is an important voice in a multidisciplinary group, aligning with the focus of active travel advice and planning contributing to all related strategy and policy work.
