MS LEE: Chair, supplementary?

THE CHAIR: Yes.

MS LEE: Just because we are on pools, we may as well. On page 41 of the report, there is a reference to the feasibility study to determine the parameters of a new pool featuring a dive pool in the Stromlo Leisure Complex, and it says in terms of the action, "The final study cost and report and submission to government was completed and submitted in November 24". Just confirming, is that public?

Ms Berry: I cannot recall. No.

Mr Khan: It is not.

MS LEE: It is not public; okay. Will it be made public?

Ms Berry: I will take it on notice. Everybody is aware of—most people should be aware of it, but I will take it on notice and see if that information can be provided.

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Dive Pool Feasibility study was conducted and provided to Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) in November 2024. This report is being used to inform future Government decisions about the Canberra Aquatic Centre (CAC) project as well as the broader Territory Aquatic Strategy. The Government intends to update the community about dive facilities in the Territory as the scope of the CAC project is refined in 2026, balancing a wide range of community and stakeholder input within the available budget.
