MS TARA CHEYNE MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The ACT Government does not have specific data related to incidences of rapid or same-day liquor delivery to playgrounds in the ACT.

The explanatory statement to the Liquor Amendment Bill 2025 notes:

In NSW, media has reported that delivery providers have delivered alcohol to locations including schools and playgrounds, failed to ask for age verification, and continued to advertise to a person who self-excluded from their services. In light of such incidents, the NSW Government introduced the *Liquor Amendment (Night-time Economy) Act 2020* (NSW) to regulate same-day deliveries of alcohol.

OFFICIAL

The media report in the *Sydney Morning Herald* references a special operation by Liquor & Gaming NSW in 2020 that targeted online alcohol deliverers and found instances of alcohol delivery to a playground, delivery to a school, and failure to verify age.
