

**PROHIBITION NOTICE – Ms [REDACTED]**

This Prohibition Notice (the Notice) is issued to you pursuant to section 182 of the *Education and Care Services National Law (ACT)* (the *Law*) and takes effect from the date of this Notice.

The grounds for issuing this Notice are outlined in the decision enclosed with this Notice.

**Effect of this Prohibition Notice**

While the notice is in force you are prohibited from doing the following:

- a) being nominated as a nominated supervisor of an education and care service;
- b) consenting to a nomination as a nominated supervisor of an education and care service.

The penalty for contravening a prohibition notice is set out in section 187 of the *Law* as \$22,900. A penalty also applies to an approved provider who engages a person to whom a prohibition notice applies.

**Cancellation of Prohibition Notice**

Under section 186 of the *Law*, you may apply to the Regulatory Authority to have the Notice cancelled at any time. Any such application must:

- a) be in writing;
- b) include any information prescribed under the Education and Care Services National Regulations (information currently prescribed is your name, contact details including address for service, and a statement setting out the grounds for the application to cancel the notice); and
- c) be signed by you.

Please note that it is an offence under the *Law* to provide me with false or misleading information or documents.
