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Dear Mr Duncan *Tom*

I write in relation to the order to table, passed by the Legislative Assembly on 4 February 2026, that requires the tabling of a database of MyWay+ tap-based patronage data and a database of light rail door sensor passenger counts. The response is due on 25 February 2026.

The purpose of this letter is to request to vary the terms of the order pursuant to Standing Order 213B.

In preparing the databases, it has become apparent that the size of the return, if printed for tabling, would consist of several hundreds of thousands of pages. I do not consider this would be an appropriate use of public resources, an acceptable environmental outcome or be practically useful to Member of the Legislative Assembly for interrogating the data.

Proposed variations to the order are provided in the attached Amendment to Motion. The variations would require a summary of the data be provided to the Assembly pursuant to 213A and that the full databases be made available to Members upon request and in electronic format only.

The proposed variations to the order seek to meet the intent of the Assembly in requesting this information in a practical and sustainable manner.
