9 Objects of Act

- (1) The main object of this Act is to minimise the harm, or potential for harm, associated with the consumption of liquor by regulating the sale, supply, promotion and consumption of liquor.
- (2) In regulating the sale, supply, promotion and consumption of liquor, the other objects of this Act are—
 - (a) to facilitate the responsible development of the liquor and hospitality industries in a way that takes into account community safety; and
 - (b) to encourage and support liquor consumers to take responsibility for—
 - (i) their consumption of liquor; and
 - (ii) their behaviour if it is affected by the consumption of liquor; and

- (c) to contribute to the responsible development of—
 - (i) the ACT's night-time economy; and
 - (ii) industries related to the ACT's night-time economy, including the liquor, live music, entertainment, tourism and hospitality industries.
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
