THE CHAIR: So where would you find that for the capital projects?

Ms Dowdell: So we have a quarterly capital works program report.

THE CHAIR: And does that list all the procurements—does that build it up as the quarters go by, that adds the procurements so it builds—

Ms Dowdell: It includes the total project value. Our colleagues who will be here for the next sitting will have more detail. But there is a range of information in that quarterly report. As I said, it does not align then with what has been done in terms of the procurement, but it would just provide the total project value and expenditure to date, I think it includes, but I will confirm that.

MS RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Amongst other reporting fields, the Quarterly Capital Works reports contain project budgets and year-to-date available funding and expenditure.
