**INQUIRY INTO THE
NEEDS OF ACT STUDENTS WITH A DISABILITY**

Terms of reference

On Thursday 25 June 2009, the Legislative Assembly for the ACT referred to the Standing Committee on Education, Training and Youth Affairs for inquiry and report the level of unmet need for educational services for all students with a disability in ACT government and non-government schools, with particular reference to:

- o community and parental experiences, satisfaction and attitudes;
- o educational outcomes;
- o the findings of the Special Education Review into leading international and Australian practice in curriculum and pedagogy for students with disabilities;
- o the provision of services, such as therapy and transport, to support educational needs of students;
- o post-school options, transitions and later year pathways for students with a disability; and
- o any other related matters.
