Question to the Minister for the Arts and Heritage –

In relation to Indigenous Arts/Multicultural Arts –

1. What projects and activities are undertaken by the Indigenous Arts Officer
2. Is there a multicultural arts officer? If so, what projects and activities are undertaken?

Mr Stanhope: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The ACT Community Arts Office consists of an Indigenous Arts Officer, a Multicultural Arts Officer and an Arts Ability Officer. The Indigenous Arts Officer and the Multicultural Arts Officer undertake a range of activities including:

- assisting the Indigenous and Multicultural communities with developing, planning, implementing, promoting and evaluating their arts projects;
- information provision
- supporting Key Arts Organisations and other arts and community organisations that wish to undertake Indigenous and Multicultural arts activities; and
- providing advice and information on funding and assistance in the preparation of applications.
