Children's pod playground - Gates have now been put on the playground that cannot be closed -  
explanation for why the gates are not being used?

**CHIEF MINISTER: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-**

The sliding entry gates and fencing between the Pod Playground and the service road were specifically installed at the Pod Playground to actively manage access by the public when maintenance of the playground or surrounding area is being undertaken, or when deliveries are being made to the Visitor Centre via the service road. Outside these occasions the sliding gates are kept open to allow convenient access.
