The Club's support contributes to the running of our social programs for the benefit of the ACT community

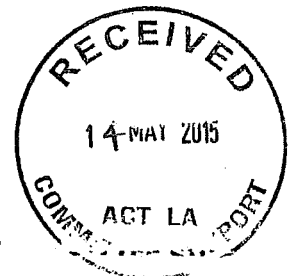
The ongoing assistance of the **Canberra Southern Cross Club** is important for our work and is something that can only be maintained by this Club if they are able to remain a viable community asset.
