Thankyou for the opportunity to offer suggested changes to the proposed draft plan.

1. Sunlight be maximised in both central courtyard and smaller square outside supermarket entrance by keeping existing building heights to 1 or 2 stories.
2. The issue of small size of lane between the butcher and the halel shop be addressed with creative solutions.
3. Retain the surface carparks (southern and eastern next to the newsagent) because parking availability is central to the centre's convenience and function.
4. Retain the park n ride site because it is critical for many of the public transport users to access public transport and jobs and services. I use this car park to access theatre and picture theatres both during the week and weekends as well as shopping trips to the city. I meet up with other friends at this car park and catch the blue rapid to the city.
5. Identify walking and cycling connections;
6. Identify open spaces within the centre
