In relation to:



MS CHEYNE: Just quickly, Adobe Pro, how many licences do we have versus users?

Mr Tanton: Might be one for Gary. I am not sure on that one actually.

Mr Davis: No, that is all right. Adobe Pro is one of those areas we have recently done a whole of government agreement on, so that is the end user agreement. I cannot tell you exactly how many we have versus a licence. I will have to take that as a question on notice. I can only tell you we now have a whole of government agreement over three years for the whole of government.

And during that piece of work that we did that, we did a lot of rationalisation with each directorate around their usage. But I will have to come back to you with the specifics of how many numbers we have actually rolled out across government.

MS CHEYNE: Okay. If you could, that would be great; thank you.

Minister for Government Services and Procurement: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The number of Adobe Acrobat Pro licences currently held by the ACT Government is 2,701.

The number of installs (as at last review in August 2018) within the ACT Government is 2,670.
