In relation to: How many people attended the Moon Exhibition at the Heritage Library

MS LAWDER: Thanks. I have a library question too. Firstly, just briefly, I visited your moon exhibition in the Heritage Library. I know it was more technically in the current financial year, but the preparation was last financial year. How did—how was the feedback on that particular—

Ms Little: The feedback was very good. I am afraid I would have to take it on notice about how many people came to have a look at it. But it was very good. It was a very early opportunity for us to use that new facility. And I know that the staff really enjoyed working with the celebration committee in putting it together.

Track Me to the Moon: Apollo 11 and Canberra exhibition was a partnership between ArchivesACT, the ACT Heritage Library, and the Apollo 11 50th Anniversary Committee.

The exhibition opened on 13 March 2019 as part of the formal opening of the new ACT Heritage Library. It closed on 30 June 2019.

According to the manual count of entry attendance, 550 people visited the exhibition.
