ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Miss C Burch MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport

Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate, 2018–19 Annual Report, output class 2.1 Roads and Infrastructure.

In relation to: Procurement of a new integrated ticketing system for Transport Canberra

- (1) Can the Minister provide a breakdown of i) the procurement process ii) cost of procurement and delivery and iii) expected rollout date for the new integrated ticketing system and NXTBUS replacement
- (2) Can the Minister provide a reason as to why the contract for MyWay operations has been extended to 2022, and a breakdown of the costs associated with this contract?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

- (1) The ACT Government recently went out to market for a new ticketing system through an Expression of Interest process and is currently evaluating a preferred solution for the replacement of the existing system. A future ticketing system will provide a modern ticketing solution that will allow multi-modal travel and assist users to take control of their own journeys.
- (2) The Government is negotiating an extension to the contract for MyWay operations to 2022, to ensure continuity for public transport users while a decision is made in relation to a new ticketing system. Given that negotiations are ongoing, the final cost is yet to be determined.
