So how many young people are going through that court process? And what are the recidivism rates?  
How long has it been going for?

Shane Rattenbury MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The Warrumbul Court was launched in November 2019.

11 young people are currently engaged in the circle sentencing process.

In addition, three young people have completed the process none of whom have reoffended.
