Asked by Mr Davis MLA:

In relation to:

Number of teachers that have engaged in professional learning in relation to the Money Smart program.

Minister Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

In relation to the ACT Government's existing *MoneySmart for Teachers* National Partnership Agreement with the Commonwealth. Participation, between January 2020 to December 2020, included:

- 116 teachers from 54 ACT public schools completed at least one *MoneySmart* professional development course.
- 62 teachers from 26 non-government schools completed at least one *MoneySmart* professional development course.

When undertaking a *MoneySmart* professional development course, participants have the option to disclose the school or organisation that they work for. Actual participation rates are therefore likely to be higher than outlined above.
