Asked by Ms Lawder:

MS LAWDER: It was also a sponsored Facebook post saying upgraded playgrounds, but when you clicked on it, there was no further detail.

Mr Steel: Yes. Well, if you-

MS LAWDER: So why are you advertising it if you do not actually have a plan to do it?

Mr Steel: Look, well, we have actually upgraded a range of playgrounds around Tuggeranong.

MS LAWDER: No, but that—

Mr Steel: Kambah shops. We have built a new one. That is-

MS LAWDER: Upcoming, not the past. The budget. We are talking about the budget, not the annual report.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

Under the 20-21 BIF program playground works will be undertaken at eleven playgrounds within the Tuggeranong region (listed below). These priority sites were selected for minor works through the 2019-20 audit process.

- Chisholm Dalyell Street, Proctor Street;
- Kambah Armon Place, Coghill Close, Deuchar Close, Faithfull Circuit, Horton Close, Summerland Circuit (North);
- Monash Cockroft Avenue;
- Theodore Lawrence Wackett Crescent; and
- Wanniassa Whiteman Street.
