Annual Reports—Surveillance Devices—2020–21

For financial year 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021, the following information is reported by the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC) under s 38 of the *Crimes (Surveillance Devices) Act 2010* (ACT):

- No applications for warrants were made by, and no warrants were issued to, officers of the ACIC: s 38(1)(a)
- No applications for emergency authorisations were made by, and none were given to, officers of the ACIC: s 38(1)(b)
- No remote applications for warrants were made by officers of the ACIC: s 38(1)(c)
