Asked by Ms Jo Clay MLA:

In relation to: Growing the Public Transport Network

- 1. Will the increased investment from "Growing the public transport network" allow for hourly weekend bus services?
- 2. Does Transport Canberra currently have a timeline for the introduction of hourly weekend bus services? How much is this expected to cost and when can this be expected to begin?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. The investment in the 2021-22 ACT Budget for 'Growing the public transport network' is specifically focused on delivering public transport services to new suburbs of Canberra as our city continues to grow.
- 2. Transport Canberra is currently developing the next tranche of network improvements, and is considering opportunities to increase weekend frequency as part of this network design.
