Elizabeth Kikkert: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services

Ref: Attorney General, Budget paper D, page number 35, output class 1 Justice Services

In relation to: Line item “Rapid Rollout of ‘screwdriver ready’ minor capital works projects” on page 35.

1. Can the Minister provide a more detailed description of what this line item entails?
2. Can the Minister provide an itemised list of what this line item will be used for and at what cost for each item?
3. Where will these projects be built/developed?

Shane Rattenbury MLA: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:–

Project name	Total budget \$'000	Description of project
ESA Digital Media capability upgrade – Fire and Rescue stations	125	This project is to expand the current digital media upgrade project to include upgrades to all nine ACT Fire and Rescue Stations (South Tuggeranong, Chisholm, Aranda, West Belconnen, Fyshwick, Gungahlin, Ainslie, Phillip, Kambah). This upgrade will enable digital conferencing and online remote training at all stations. This project allows the agency to have structured communications directly with staff.
ACT Ambulance Service Non-Emergency patient transport (NEPT)	50	This project would manage the growth of NEPT and the expansion of work capacity by preparing and planning for a drive through engine bay. This will reduce the need to reverse vehicles at the NEPT site in Kambah shared with ACT Fire and Rescue. This project includes the design, engineering and relevant approvals in anticipation of construction.
ACT Courts - Culturally sensitive waiting area	81	This project is for the development of a private waiting space for Indigenous court users to support wellbeing and access to appropriate guidance services while attending court (Knowles Place).
City Station upgrade - stage 2	300	This project is to undertake bathroom, shower and toilet upgrades on level two of the City Police Station (London Circuit). The upgrade will include the transition to energy saving lighting in these areas and more hygienic touchless bathroom technology.
Rapid roll out of screwdriver ready minor capital works projects	556
