In relation to: Strategic Policy New Initiatives

1. What are the new initiatives mentioned note 2 to Table 5?

RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The new initiatives mentioned in note 2 to Table 5 of the Community Services, Budget Statement G, relate to Raising the Minimum Age of Criminal Responsibility and amendments to the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

The ACT Government committed to raising the minimum age of criminal responsibility in the Parliamentary Governing Agreement for the 10<sup>th</sup> Legislative Assembly.

A number of reforms currently underway will require amendment to the *Children and Young People Act 2008*, including raising the minimum age of criminal responsibility, embedding a model for external review of child protection decisions and implementing a charter of rights for families involved in child protection.
