In relation to: City Presentation

1. Minister, what work is being done to deal with weed infestations in town centres, particularly around drains and swales?
2. How often are these areas maintained?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. City Services undertakes an annual suburban spray program that targets a range of assets at varying times of the year, based on priority and seasonal conditions. Town centres are prioritised under the framework as a high use asset.
2. These areas are maintained on a cyclic seasonal program, with attention to autumn, spring and summer when weed growth is at its maximum.
