ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE
23 February 2022

Asked by Andrew Braddock MLA on 23 February 2022: Mr Ray Johnson took on notice the following question:

In relation to: Persons discharged from the AMC each calendar year

MR BRADDOCK: I suppose one final question is, how many people on average were discharged from the AMC each calendar year?

Mr Johnson: That one I would definitely need to take on notice. We can have a look at that, what the turnover would be, keeping in mind that some of them were discharged as remandees as a result of a sentence potentially or being not guilty or ultimately not getting a custodial sentence. We would have to look at specifically those that were sentenced and had been released. But I am sure those figures are available; I just need to take them on notice.

Acting Minister for Corrections: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

For the 2021 calendar year, a total of 757 detainees were released from the Alexander Maconochie Centre. The table below reflects the breakdown for each month, and whether the detainee was on remand or sentenced.
