ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by Mr Peter Cain MLA on 30 August 2022: Mr John Dietz took on notice the following question(s):

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MR CAIN: And you able to provide a list of current parcels in commercial and industrial zoning that SLA has in its precinct?

Mr Barr: That SLA has? Well the government has—

THE CHAIR: The government, yes.

Mr Barr: —I think would be the—

MR CAIN: Yes. Yes.

Mr Barr: Yes, we can provide that. There is not many—

MR CAIN: Okay, thank—

Mr Barr: Because you have identified commercial and industrial?

MR CAIN: Correct.

Mr Barr: Yes.

ANDREW BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

The Suburban Land Agency has sold all blocks of land it was responsible for in the City Renewal Precinct except for Block 3 Section 57 in Turner. This site is zoned CZ5 and is scheduled for release in 2022-23 for Build-to-Rent.

The City Renewal Authority has the following parcels of land for sale or identified for future sale. These are mixed-use (commercial and residential) sites.

- Block 40, Section 100, City.
- Blocks 2 and 3, Section 20, City This site is currently identified for release on the Indicative Land Release Program in financial year 2022-23.
- Block 1 Section 119, City (previously referred to as Part Block 20, Section 63, City) –
 This site is currently identified for release on the <u>Indicative Land Release Program</u> in
 financial year 2022-23.

- Block 38, Section 19, City This site is located in the Canberra Civic and Culture
 District and is currently identified for release on the <u>Indicative Land Release</u>
 <u>Program</u> in financial year 2024-25.
- Part Block 23, Section 19, City This site is located in the Canberra Civic and Culture
 District and is currently identified for release on the <u>Indicative Land Release</u>
 <u>Program</u> in financial year 2025-26.

Other sites within the City Renewal Precinct which may be available in the future following appropriate due diligence investigations and urban planning reviews include:

- Part Block 12, Section 33, Reid;
- Acton Waterfront Precinct;
- Block 1, Section 116, City;
- Blocks 7 and 9, Section 37, City; and
- Block 14 Section 65 City.
